6. Offer varied housing and employment choices for people of all life stages.
7. Provide a range of recreational amenities that are gathering places and connect to the Town Center.
8. Ensure a safe, secure, and accessible town, both day and night.
9. Create a Town Center where civic buildings and uses are distinct, prominent, and connected.
10. Encourage individual developments to seamlessly link to their surroundings and achieve the Town's Cornerstone Principles.
